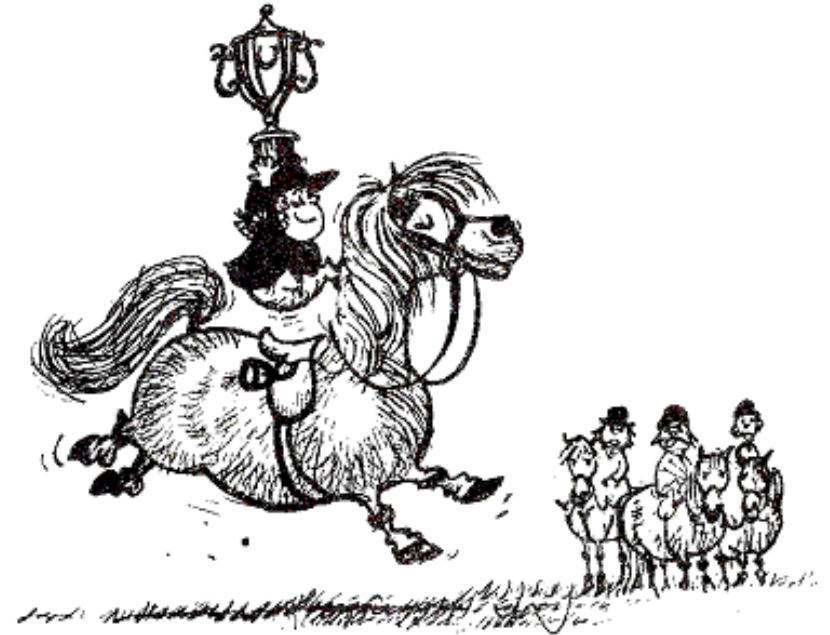

RULES & REGULATIONS

- USEF and USEA rules will be used as a general guideline for this competition.
- Six ribbons will be awarded in each division
- Riders may not enter more than two horses at one level, and the same horse/rider combination may only enter one level of the 2-phase competition. Entry of a horse in more than one level of the 2-phase division with different riders will be accepted subject to scheduling availability.
- Start times will be available at www.westonshows.com on Wednesday prior to the event.
- Dressage attire: Uniform or hunting attire, including hunt cap or regulation headgear.
- Jumping attire: Cross-country or hunting attire is acceptable at this competition. **Regulation headgear with a secured safety harness & approved safety vest must be worn at any time when jumping.** Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- Saddlery: Per USEF/USEA rules.
- No schooling will be permitted over the course at any time.
- All entries must show proof of negative Coggins test within one year.
- The show committee reserves the right to dismiss any person or animal from the grounds at any time.
- There will be no refund of entry fees for any reason unless the request is received prior to the closing date, and is accompanied by a veterinary or physician's certificate. In the event of cancellation of the event due to extreme weather, a pro-rated refund will be made after expenses are paid.
- All entries must be accompanied by payment – no exceptions.
- The show committee reserves the right to limit entries if necessary. If oversubscribed, a waiting list will be formed.
- If a competitor is eliminated with three refusals at a fence, s/he may continue past that fence and complete the course.
- In the interest of safety, **all dogs must be on a leash!**

Directions to the Ruth B. Dickson Memorial Rings

From Route 20 Westbound: Route 128 to Route 20 West. Turn right at the first set of traffic lights onto School St. Turn left at the top of the hill onto Boston Post Road. Continue through Weston Center and turn right onto Concord Road just as you leave the Center (small traffic island). After approximately 1 mile, bear left at the fork. Rings are approx ½ mile on left.

From Route 20 Eastbound: Fork left to Weston Center just after passing the Red Barn School. Take 3rd left onto Concord Road (small traffic island) just before you reach Weston Center. After approximately 1 mile, bear left at the fork. Rings are approximately ½ mile on left.

2-PHASE DIVISIONS: All jumping phases will be held over the outside course utilizing **cross-country rules** (includes pre-elementary). Fences are **permanent, cross-country type obstacles**. Course will be open for inspection after 5:00 PM on Friday preceding the event. **Note:** Approved safety vest must be worn any time when jumping.

Pre-elementary 2-Phase:

Dressage: USDF Introductory Level Test B

Jumping: A very basic course on the outside course comprised of both cross-country and show jumping type obstacles. Fences not to exceed 18", with approximately 7-8 jumping efforts. No time limit.

Elementary 2-Phase:

Dressage: Beginner Novice Event Test B

Jumping: Cross-country type fences not to exceed 2'0", with approximately 8-10 jumping efforts. No time limit.

Beginner Novice 2-Phase:

Dressage: Beginner Novice Event Test B

Jumping: Cross-country type fences not to exceed 2'6", with approximately 10-14 jumping efforts. No time limit.

Novice 2-Phase:

Dressage: Novice Event Test A

Jumping: Cross-country type fences not to exceed 2'11", with approximately 12-16 jumping efforts. No time limit.

CROSS-COUNTRY PACE TESTS

All pace tests will be ridden over the outside course immediately following the corresponding 2-phase division (rider may be different from the rider who rode the 2-phase, subject to scheduling availability). Penalties to be assigned as follows:

- Each second off of the optimum time: 1.0 penalty
- Jump penalties per USEA rules
- In the case of a tie, the entry who does not go over the optimum time will receive the higher placing. If the entries are still tied, the tie will not be broken.

Pre-Elementary Pace: 250 mpm

Elementary Pace: 325 mpm

Beginner Novice Pace: 325 mpm
